PREVENT CRABGRASS NOW!

(This is the first of 4 or 5 pre-m applications for the year).

20-5-10-4% Fe + pre-m

Pre-emergents kill the seeds before they become weeds.

- With 50% slow release nitrogen, lawns will stay green with fewer clippings
- A 4-1-2 nutrient ratio is perfect for lawns
- It contains potassium sulfate, not potassium chloride (the chloride adds toxicity to the soil)
- The 4% iron sucrate, is a non-staining form of iron (which will help green-up winter lawns)
- Both the fertilizer and pre-emergent will last 8-10 weeks
- The active ingredient is Pendimethalin (the most effective single ingredient pre-emergent)



TREE CARE



1. Prune your deciduous trees and shrubs (including roses). For trees, about one-third of the wood should be removed. For help in pruning, we carry several helpful books, one of which is R. Sanford Martin's book on pruning.
2. After pruning, you should spray your tree with dormant oil. Adding an insecticide like Monterey's Bug Buster II™ helps increase insect control.
3. January is the perfect time to fertilize trees by deep-root feeding. "Super 10" is perfect for all trees except oak and olive trees, where you should rather use "No Nite" (no nitrogen on these two trees).
4. Apply a systemic insecticide as a soil soak around the base of your trees to protect your trees and plants all season or all year long.



Season/Year Long Insect Control on Plants and Trees



Applications of Merit™ should be made in January so the insecticide will be in the plant by spring. Merit™ is a systemic that works through the vascular system of the plant. One application will give you season long control in most trees, shrubs, and plants. Merit™ kills insects such as aphids, borers, scales, leathoppers, leaf miners, whiteflies, white grub larva, and more. Merit™ is also available for application on fruit trees, nut trees, and vegetables. There are two concentrations you may use: the lower concentration for fruits and vegetables and the higher concentration for everything else.

HERE ARE SOME SUGGESTIONS:

- For trees, deep root feed with our "Super 10", 10-10-10+10% iron sucrate. This fertilizer is formulated for trees, especially high iron users like redwoods and liquid ambar.
- For ornamentals, roses, and shrubs use our 7-20-20 "Trophy Blend" and apply on top of the ground. As for iron and zinc, they can come from several sources. Bring in a soil test so we can suggest the best product for your yard.
- For lawns use Turf Royale™, 21-7-14.



- Cloud Cover™ is a liquid spray providing a protective coating that will lock in the moisture so your trees, shrubs, and flowers will make it through the cold months. Best results will be obtained when Cloud Cover™ is applied 24 to 48 hours before drought/wind/heat, frost/freeze, or transplant shock occurs. Make sure to hydrate your plants well before using Cloud Cover™.
- Burlap or frost blankets are always a great defense against the frost.



WINTER WEED CONTROL



In cool season lawns (fescue, Bakersfield Mix, or perennial rye), broadleaf weeds can be controlled using Weed Free Zone™ or Trimec™. In dormant bermuda lawns, use a tank mix of Weed Free Zone™ and Alligare Diquat™. This mixture kills grassy weeds as well as broadleaf weeds like oxalis, wild carrot, and dandelion. The diquat will top-burn grassy weeds, which means some may come back from the roots. You may need to use Amaze™ later to root-prune those tougher-rooted grassy weeds.



HOW TO GET THE BEST RESULTS FROM SPRAYS AGAINST WEEDS:

- First, mow your lawn. Wait 2 days to apply the material.
- NO water or rain for 24 hours after spraying.
- If you apply the combination of Weed Free Zone™ and Alligare Diquat™ on cloudy or foggy days, the material will work slowly (if you use the diquat, try to spray on sunny days for better results). Use the higher rates allowed on the label for the Alligare Diquat™. The addition of a non-ionic surfactant is a necessity to help the material work properly, especially if you spray diquat alone.
- Do not spray on windy days.
- Cover your entire lawn. There may be weeds that have germinated but you cannot see them yet.
- In dormant, non-overseeded bermuda lawns, any unusual perennial weeds not killed by the treatment of Weed Free Zone™ and Alligare Diquat™ should be “spot treated” with glyphosate (at lighter rates) while bermuda is still brown and dormant.
- This process does not kill weed seeds. Rather, use a pre-emergent to kill weed seeds.
- There is very little soil residual from these tank mixes.
- If you do not know what kind of weeds you have, pull some and bring them in. We will be glad to identify them for you.
