DO THE ANT "TWO STEP"

Step #1 - Bait



Always bait first! The worker ants carry bait to the nest, which in turn is fed to the immature ants who feed it to the larva. The queen, while grooming the larva, ingests the regurgitated poison. This results in the killing of the whole colony.

Step #2 - Contact

Two days after applying the bait, apply a contact insecticide to kill any "straggler" ants remaining on the surface and to kill other yard insects.

Which Ant Bait Do I Use?

We have two different types of baits. One attracts "grease loving" ants and one attracts "sugar loving" ants. You can find out which ants you have by observing their eating habits at home or by baiting them with a potato chip. The ants that eat the chip will be attracted to grease (Amdro™ Fire Ant). The ants that do not eat the potato chip will be attracted to sugars (Amdro™ Ant Block). When in doubt use the Amdro™ Ant Block.



SUMMER INSECT CONTROL



Perimeter Treatment - Use Bug Buster™ or Demon Max™ for spraying outside the home. Add two tablespoons of plant food (Super Bloom™) to acidify the water which makes the spray last two times longer.

Plants and Trees - Use systemic soil soaks to give you 12 months protection. Mix and pour at the base of plants and trees. Several foliar sprays (like Maxide™) work well for shorter durations. For roses, use Dexol™ (the "yellow jug") for both insect control and fertilization.



Vegetables - Use a soil drench (Monterey™) or a foliar spray (spinosad, Sevin™, or Bug Buster™), all of which are still safe for harvest.



Lawns - We suggest the use of granular products due to their longer residual. Rotate active ingredients monthly or bi-monthly to keep insects from building resistance to a particular product. However, insects never grow resistant to Sevin™ (carbaryl). If you have grubs, use Amdro Quick Kill™ or Arena™ for effective, long lasting results against grubs.

These products can be used in addition to the grassy weed pre-emergent pendimethalin (0-0-5 or 20-5-10 + pre-m) for a full spectrum of pre-emergent control. Bayer Season Long™ and Gallery® can be applied as late as 2 months before re-seeding or over-seeding. Trimec™ can be used up to 3-4 weeks before re- or over-seeding.

CONQUER NUTGRASS WITH NUTSEGE CONTROL™

This is the same material and packaging as Manage™, SedgeHammer™, and Prosedge™. Add 2 teaspoons of a non-ionic surfactant (N-90™, No Foam A or Spreader Sticker) per gallon of water. Shake aggressively before and during use. Use the mixed solution on the same day. Repeat applications are usually necessary.

HYBRID BERMUDA GRASS FROM SEED

The summer is a perfect time to start a new Bermuda lawn (or to fill-in large bare spots) and seeding is always cheaper than putting down sod. We have units that will cover smaller and larger areas. Coverage for hybrid Bermuda is one pound of seed per 1,000 sq. ft. and costs \$49 per pound.



REMEMBER: Let us test your soil (for free!) to make sure you have optimal growing conditions. Use 7-20-20 with your new seed and keep the seedlings moist through the day with multiple waterings. (You will need 1 ½ inches of mulch over the seed to keep it moist if you water only 3 times per week).
